### 4. Treasurer Update

Current Bank balance and recent transactions - £260.14 (as of 10<sup>th</sup> December). Rich explained that the balance was noticeable lower than expected as the first order to purchase Manchester City items from MCFC which was ordered on Black Friday (£183.60) may not arrive for tonight's meeting, so to make sure we had Manchester City items for tonight's meeting, Rich ordered a second supply of Manchester City items via Amazon last weekend (£152.72)...the original order from MCFC however arrived on the afternoon of the 7<sup>th</sup> (just in time for the meeting as the items were sent from the Netherlands).
